	Electrical motors shall be maintained in a condition free from accumulation of excessive oil, dirt, waste, or debris (CFC §605.8).		
	Portable power strips shall be plugged directly into an approved power supply. Power strips shall be of the polarized, grounde type and equipped with proper overcurrent protection (CFC §605.4).
